



Downloading Library Books to Your Nook

Here are step-by-step instructions on how to get digital content on your Nook.

Step A. How to Check Out an EPUB or PDF eBook

Using your personal computer with an Internet connection:

1. Visit the **Downloadable Media** page at rutlandfree.org
2. Click on the **Listen Up! Vermont** link or go to listenupvermont.org to find a book
3. Click **Add to Basket**
4. Click **Proceed to Checkout**
5. Select **Rutland Free Library** option from the Library drop down menu
6. Type your **Library Card number** in the box
7. Click **Confirm Checkout**

Step B. How to Download to your PC

You must have Adobe Digital Editions software installed and authorized with an Adobe ID. The first time you run Adobe Digital Editions, you are prompted to authorize the application by entering an Adobe ID.

If you don't have an Adobe ID, visit: www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/

1. Click the **Download** button
2. Click the **Open** button on the **File Download** box
3. Adobe Digital editions will open to display the downloaded book

Step C. How to Transfer from Your Computer to Your Nook

1. Connect your Nook to your computer with the USB cable
2. The Nook will confirm that it is safe to transfer files
3. Click on the **Library View** button in **Adobe Digital Editions**
4. Left click and drag a book from the right side to the left panel where you see your Media device (Nook) listed
5. Click **Safely Remove Device** option found in the lower right hand corner
6. After the **"Safe to Remove Hardware"** message displays, unplug your Nook from your computer

Step D. How to Begin Reading on Your Nook

1. Press the **Menu** button on the Nook
2. Press the **Library** button and press the My Files button
3. Press the **Digital Editions** icon
4. Press the book you downloaded
5. Read!
